REGULATIONS CONCERNING ACCEPTANCE TO AND  
PLACEMENT IN THE CAMPUS DORMITORIES

I) DORM SCORE = BASIC SCORE + EXTRA POINTS – REDUCTIONS

II) BASIC SCORE

A) Socio-economic level (maximum 50 points)

A1- Family income (maximum 30 points)

YTL: The total net income of the whole family by considering all types of income such as the salary, rent, revenues etc., as the average of the last 12 months in New Turkish Liras.

$$\frac{(ave.YTL + std) - YTL}{2 * std} * 30$$

(If  $YTL > (ave.YTL + std)$  then 0; If  $YTL < (ave.YTL - std)$  then 30)

A2- House or apartment flat owned by parents, siblings or the student:

Yes: 10 points

None: 0 points

A3- Number of brothers and sisters pursuing higher education (maximum 10 points)

For each brother/sister living with the family: 5 points

For each brother/sister living in a different city: 3 points

B) Academic Performance (maximum 50 points)

English Preparatory School:

NOT: Average of the yearly overall grade (available at the time of application) and METU English Proficiency grade (if available at the time of application)

$$\frac{NOT - (ave.NOT - 2 * std)}{4 * std} * 50$$

(If  $NOT > (ave.NOT + 2 * std)$  then 50; If  $NOT < (ave.NOT - 2 * std)$  then 0)

(If another English Proficiency Examination grade has been submitted, NOT is taken as the corresponding METU English Proficiency grade in the equivalence table)

Undergraduate Program:

*ave. CGPA*: Average of the CGPA scores of the student's program

$$\frac{CGPA - (ave.CGPA - 2 * std)}{4 * std} * 50$$

(If  $CGPA > (ave.CGPA + 2 * std)$  then 50; If  $CGPA < (ave.CGPA - 2 * std)$  then 0)

New Enrollments:

PUAN: ÖSS or YÖS examination score used for admission (PUAN will be decided by the administration for those international students admitted with other equivalent exam scores or and for transfer students on the basis of ÖSS or YÖS score scales, as appropriate.

*ave.PUAN*: Average ÖSS or YÖS score for the student's program, as appropriate.

$$\frac{PUAN - (ave.PUAN - 2 * std)}{4 * std} * 50$$

(If  $PUAN > (ave.PUAN + 2 * std)$  then 50; If  $PUAN < (ave.PUAN - 2 * std)$  then 0)

III) EXTRA POINTS

- A) ÖSS Scholarships (Dormitory/Education): 40 points
- B) Students supported by Campus Bursaries Fund: 30 points
- C) Nationality (In case of multiple nationality, the lowest extra point will apply).
  - TRNC 0 points
  - T.C. 30 points
  - Other: 50 points
- D) Location where parents reside (If parents live in different locations, the lower extra point will apply).
  - Outside TRNC: 40 points
  - Karpaz Area: 35 points
  - Magosa Area: 30 points
  - Lefkoşa / Girne Area: 10 points
  - Lefke Area: 5 points
  - Güzelyurt Area: 0 points

IV) REDUCTIONS

- A) Disciplinary Action
  - Temporary Dismissal:  
GUN: Number of days (for the formula)

- Reprimand: 25 points
- Warning: 15 points

Point reduction due to disciplinary actions in accordance with both the “University Disciplinary Regulations” and the “Dormitory Disciplinary Regulations” are considered cumulatively.

The total point reduction due to disciplinary actions taken in a particular academic year will apply for the subsequent two academic years, wholly in the following academic year and half of it in the next. Point reduction due to disciplinary actions will be waived after two academic years.

- B) Failure to give accurate and correct information in the application form, and failure to pay dormitory fee as scheduled: 10-100 points (will be decided by the Dormitory Administrative Board).
- C) Failure to accept and pay the fee for the room assigned: 50 points (in the subsequent placement period of the same academic year.)
- D) Repeating the application in the following placement period of the same academic year, to change the room type assigned and accepted. 10 points.

#### V) SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE TO CAMPUS DORMS

- A) The following students are accepted in the Campus Dorms regardless of their Dorm Score, providing the point reduction due to articles IV-A and B does not exceed 50 points:
  - Dormitory Scholarship holders
  - Disabled students
  - International students (providing 7 room-type preferences are indicated by male students and 4 room-type preferences are indicated by female students).
  - New enrolments (except TRNC nationals and residents, and providing 7 room-type preferences are indicated by male students and 4 room-type preferences are indicated by female students).
- B) The following students are not accepted to Campus Dorms regardless of their Dorm Score:
  - Those expelled from the Dorms in accordance with disciplinary regulations.

## VI) PLACEMENT IN THE CAMPUS DORMS (ROOM-TYPE PREFERENCES)

- A) Dormitory Scholarships are placed in 4-person rooms, providing their first preference is of this type and their total point reduction is below the limit.
- B) The other applicants are ordered according to their Dorm Score, and by taking account their preferences, accepted and placed in the room types available for that placement period.
- C) The remaining students of category V-A are placed in one of their preferences in the same process as above.
- D) If those placed in a particular room type fail to make the payments according to the schedule announced by the Dormitory Administrative Board, their room allocation is cancelled and their Dorm Score is degraded in the following placement period in accordance with article IV-C.
- E) Those placed in a particular room type may apply to change the room type in the subsequent placement period, while securing the room type already hold, with a point reduction in accordance with article IV-D.
- F) Three placements are made in every academic year:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Period: Existing students (April-May)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Period: New and existing students (September)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Period: Late registrations, existing and new students (October)
- G) A new application must be made for every placement period, and Dorm Score is recalculated in each.
- H) Room types allocated for each placement is announced by the Dormitory Administrative Board before the application period.
- I) Students admitted to the University by a special agreement are placed in dormitories in accordance with the conditions of the agreement.
- J) After the third placement, applications for acceptance to Campus dormitories and requests for changing room type are evaluated and resolved by the Dormitory Administrative Board.

1 If total point reduction due to articles IV A and B exceeds 50, dormitory scholarship is terminated in the following academic year. These students may still apply, and if their Dorm Score is sufficient, be accepted to the campus dorms by paying the fee. They may regain dorm scholarship status in the academic year for which the total point reduction is below the limit.
